Tuol Sleng in Khmer; means "Hill of the Poisonous Trees" or "Strychnine Hill".

They include the famous Temple of Angkor Wat and, at Angkor Thom, the Bayon Temple with its countless sculptural decorations.

Evening, sunset tour of Bakheng Mountain.

After exploring the amazing Angkor Temple, it is time to watch the sunset at Phnom Bakheng Mountain. The view is wonderful from the height of 65 m on the top of the hill. Phnom Bakheng is a Hindu temple dedicated to Shiva, it was built at the end of the 9th century. Located atop a hill, it is nowadays a popular tourist spot for sunset views of the much bigger temple Angkor Wat, which lies amid the jungle about 1.5 km to the southeast.
